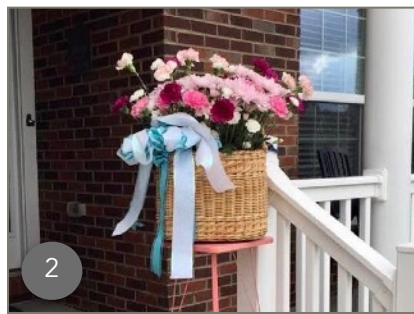
Each member may submit one photo per category per week. Photos received by Friday will be added to the digital tours by Monday.

The information on this report will help the PLGC Board make plans for next year and provide some history for future chairs of your committee. As a reminder, the password can be found on the last page of your yearbook.

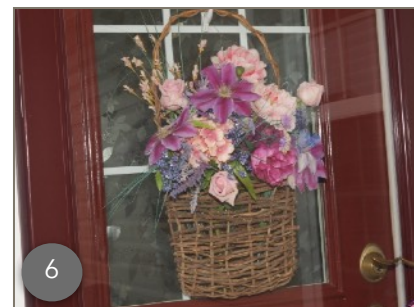
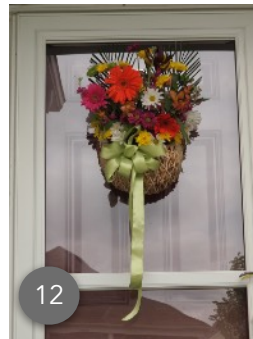
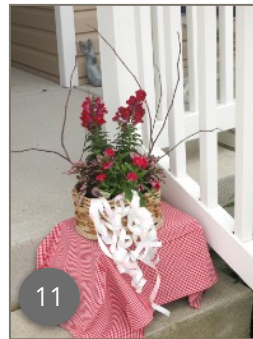
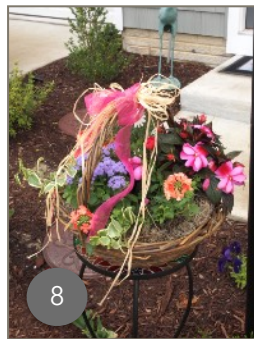
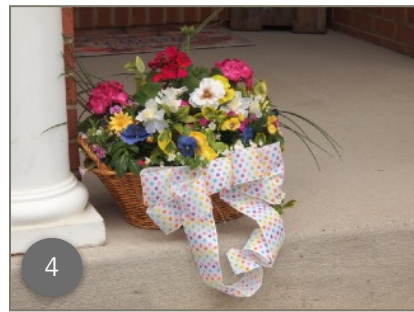


2020 May Baskets
